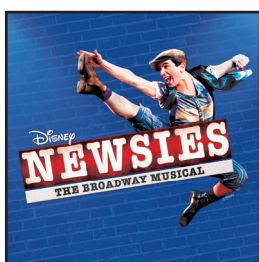
Honeymoon In Vegas
